This Power of Attorney shall be governed by and construed in accordance with the laws of the jurisdiction that the Principal is organized in.

This Power of Attorney is intended to confer rights upon DigiCert to act upon instructions from the Agent within the Scope, including the right to rely upon the authority granted herein. If any provision of this Power of Attorney is found to be invalid or unenforceable by a court of competent jurisdiction, the parties agree to take all such reasonable further actions, including by way of amending this Power of Attorney in a manner that will effectuate the original intent of the parties to the greatest extent possible.
